- 2. Telephonic, telegraphic, facsimile or emailed submissions, or any other electronic submissions, will not be accepted, unless indicated otherwise in this document.
- 3. Submissions must be marked with the RFQ description and reference number, sealed and deposited in the tender box on or before the closing date and time for submissions.
- 4. Submissions deposited in the tender box after the closing time or closing date will be considered to be late.
- 5. Late submissions will not be accepted, and where practicable, shall be returned unopened to the bidder.
- 6. O.R. Tambo District Municipality accepts no responsibility for ensuring that RFQ submissions are placed in the correct box, and submissions placed in the incorrect box will not be accepted.
- 7. Bidders are entitled to submit one quotation only, either as a single tendering entity or as a member of a joint venture or consortium.
- 8. Bidders are responsible for all costs incurred in the preparation and submission of their quotation.
- 9. The RFQ submission must be signed by a person or persons duly authorised to do so.
- 10. Once the quotation is awarded, all purchases will be made through an official O.R. Tambo District Municipality purchase order.
- 11. No goods or services must be delivered or provided before an official order has been sent to, and accepted by the successful bidder.



SECTION 3: TEST FOR RESPONSIVENESS

Invalid submissions

Quotations shall be invalid if:

- 1. The submission is not completed in non-erasable ink.
- 2. The bidder, if he or she is a natural person, is in the service of the state, or if not a natural person, a director, manager, principal shareholder of stakeholder of the bidder is in the service of the state.
- 3. The bidder is listed on the National Treasury Register of Tender Defaulters and / or List of Restricted Suppliers and is restricted from doing business with the public sector.
- 4. The bidder has been restricted from doing business with O.R. Tambo District Municipality in terms of its supply chain management policy and procedures.

Non-responsive submissions

Quotations will be declared as non-responsive and eliminated from further evaluation in the following instances:

- 1. The submission does not comply with the mandatory requirements of the RFQ, if any, including any minimum evaluation criteria.
- 2. The bidder's tax matters are found not to be in order upon verification by the Municipality on CSD, and the bidder fails to ensure that its tax matters are in order within such timeframe as may be granted by the municipality.
- 3. Where the bidder is not registered on CSD.
- 4. Where the bidder is not registered on the municipal supplier database, or does not meet the listing criteria for accredited suppliers specified in the municipality's SCM Policy, and does not register on the database or meet the listing criteria within such timeframe as may be granted by the municipality.

SECTION 5: SPECIFICATIONS AND EVALUATION CRITERIA

Background

The Port St Johns Local Municipality (PSJ LM) is one of the five local municipalities in the O.R. Tambo District Municipality. The PSJ Local Municipality attracts large volumes of tourists. The PSJ LM is located on the strategic position in the O.R. Tambo DM because O.R. Tambo was identified as the first pilot District Development Model (DDM) which was launched by President Cyril Ramaphosa in 2019. The Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs (COGTA) has emphasised the institutionalisation of long-range planning through the DDM as a key element to realising the potential of a new coastal city.

In 2020/21 financial year Port St Johns Municipality developed its Spatial Development Framework (SDF) to guide development in a manner where changes, needs and growth can be managed for the benefit of the community.

In terms of population dynamics, 3% of the communities in Port St Johns live in town while 97% of the communities live in dispersed rural settlements which pose challenges to service delivery and quality of living standards. The PSJ LM has for years experienced challenges of sprawling unlawful development in the coastal zone, lack of service infrastructure, destruction of coastal forest illegal mining and alien plant invasions. Port St Johns Municipality has a high demand for affordable housing. However, the municipality has not been able to respond to this need. It is the intention of the Municipality to create sustainable communities that are self-sufficient and sustainable.

In order to address the need for integrated human settlements, PSJ LM has identified the Old Military Base (ERF 646) which is partly shared by the PSJ LM and Cuguba Community Property association (CPA) for Township Establishment.



This project is essentially proposed in the backdrop of creating a project that integrates development, economic development and infrastructure upgrade within the scope of Urban Renewal. Through the Spatial Development Framework, the PSJ LM has identified a piece of land in the Former Military Base to develop a Township Establishment. In terms of Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act (SPLUMA), 2013 Township Establishment is one of the key aspects of land development. Township Establishment integrates various forms of developments (social-economic and environmental).

Township Establishment exercise consists of 8 Phases (see attached Project Phases). The Port St Johns Local Municipality has requested for assistance from O.R. Tambo District Municipality to assist with the Township Establishment in Ward 6. Through the technical engagements between ORTDM & PSJ LM it has been proposed that for 2022/23 Financial year the two Municipalities must focus on Phase 1 of the Project, i.e. Social Facilitation.

Scope of work

The Social Facilitator Services are expected to address amongst other things:

- Detailed engagements and negotiations between different stakeholders (Municipalities, Government, Land Claims Commission, Communities, Traditional Leaders, Youth and Women, Organised Business, NGOs, ect.).
- Facilitate community engagement and stakeholder consultation taking into account the situational analysis and better understanding of the socio-economic dynamics of the settlement, whilst involving stakeholders in the development process.
- Identify extent of housing needs and identify beneficiaries in collaboration with the Municipalities and stakeholders.
- Community mobilisation and promotion of public participation.
- Identify Community Structures and engage them in forming a Project Steering Committee which oversee the entire project from Phase 1 – 8.
- Identify Land Ownership Details.
- Provide the necessary guidance to the PSC to enable it to perform its role fairly and in the interest of the communities.
- Obtain current population statistics (of settlements/villages) from the community leaders.



- Obtain information on water infrastructure in the project area.
- Establish any potential conflicts among the community that could jeopardise the project.
- Facilitate the presentation of technical solutions to the PSC/community by the Technical Team.
- Obtain acceptance by signature (by PSC Members) of the proposed solutions.
- Advise the DM & LM on any social issues that need to be taken into account in the planning of the project.
- Prepare and submit report covering the above activities and submit to PSJ LM and ORTDM.
- The outcome of the exercise undertaken by the Social Facilitator will be the development of Draft Township Establishment Model and Draft Service Level Agreement.

1.5 Failure on the part of a bidder to submit proof of B-BBEE Status level of contributor together with the bid, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.

1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) "B-BBEE" means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (b) "B-BBEE status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status of an entity in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (d) "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (e) "EME" means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic



empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;

- (f) "functionality" means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender documents.
- (g) "prices" includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (h) "proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor" means:
 - 1) B-BBEE Status level certificate issued by an authorized body or person;
 - 2) A sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice;
 - 3) Any other requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act;
- (i) "QSE" means a qualifying small business enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (j) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;



CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- 1 This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids¹ invited.
- 2 Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).² Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.
- 3 Municipal Supply Regulation 38 (1) prescribes that a supply chain management policy must provide measures for the combating of abuse of the supply chain management system, and must enable the accounting officer, among others, to:
 - a. take all reasonable steps to prevent such abuse;

² Bid rigging (or collusive bidding) occurs when businesses, that would otherwise be expected to compete, secretly conspire to raise prices or lower the quality of goods and / or services for purchasers who wish to acquire goods and / or services through a bidding process. Bid rigging is, therefore, an agreement between competitors not to compete.
