SECTION 3: TEST FOR RESPONSIVENESS

Invalid submissions

- 3. The bidder is listed on the National Treasury Register of Tender Defaulters and / or List of Restricted Suppliers and is restricted from doing business with the public sector.
- 4. The bidder has been restricted from doing business with O.R. Tambo District Municipality in terms of its supply chain management policy and procedures.

Non-responsive submissions

Quotations will be declared as non-responsive and eliminated from further evaluation in the following instances:

- 1. The submission does not comply with the mandatory requirements of the RFQ, if any, including any minimum evaluation criteria.
- The bidder's tax matters are found not to be in order upon verification by the Municipality on CSD, and the bidder fails to ensure that its tax matters are in order within such timeframe as may be granted by the municipality.
- 3. Where the bidder is not registered on CSD.
- 4. Where the bidder is not registered on the municipal supplier database, or does not meet the listing criteria for accredited suppliers specified in the municipality's SCM Policy, and does not register on the database or meet the listing criteria within such timeframe as may be granted by the municipality.

SECTION: 6 SCOPE OF WORK

All definitions, interpretations and general provisions for the General Conditions of Contract for Construction Work (2015) (3rd edition) are applicable.

C 6.1 <u>DESCRIPTIONS OF WORKS</u>

C6.1.1 Client's Objective

The Clients objectives is to protect the spring in the BOMVINI village in Libode (Nyandeni Local Municipality) and surrounding areas. The contractor shall use reasonable resources. These resources include local labour, sub-contractors, and plant hire. The specification of the material should be specified by the engineer.

It is a specific goal of this project that the labour component where possible be maximised where it is economically feasible, and that the use of this labour goes hand in hand with on the job training of the labour force. The project is thus process and product orientated, and it is expected that the contractor will pursue these goals in the execution of the project.

C6.1.2 Overview of the Works

The work entails the construction of a spring box, pipe installation, storage tank installation and fencing of the spring in Libode. The proposed work requires the contractor to be ingenuitive in the approach, ensure that the spring flow is not hindered or obstructed during construction and that the water course is not contaminated during construction.

C6.1.3 Extent of the Works

The work to be carried out by the Service provider under this contract comprises mainly of the following:

- Clear and grub
- Excavation to expose spring eye
- Construction of spring eye
- The complete spring protection is shown in the attached detail drawing.

C6.1.4 Location of the Works

The site is situated in rural area of Nyandeni Local Municipality (Libode) in BOMVINI village.

C6.1.5 Construction program

It is specifically brought to the notice of the Contractor that time is critical on this project, and the construction period will be a major factor in the award of the tender.

Service providers shall submit with their tender their **Preliminary weekly programme for the construction** of the Works under this contract to suit their proposed method of executing the Works. The programme shall be sufficiently detailed to differentiate between the various activities so that the contract may be properly evaluated.



C6.1.6 Change in works

The Employer Agent may, from time to time by order in writing without in any way vitiating the Contract or giving to the Contractor any claim for additional payment, require the Contractor to proceed with the execution of the works in such order as in his opinion may be necessary, and may alter the order of or suspend any part of the Works at such time and times as he may deem desirable and the Contractor shall not, after receiving such written order, proceed with work ordered to be suspended until he shall receive a written order to do so from the Employer Agent. Where the work must of necessity be carried out in conjunction with work of other Contractors, or with that of the Employer, it shall be co-ordinated and arranged in such a manner as to Interfere as little as possible with the progress of such other work so as to offer every reasonable facility to other Contractors or to employees of the Employer.

C6.5 <u>EMPLOYMENT OF UNSKILLED AND SEMI-SKILLED WORKERS IN LABOUR INTENSIVE</u> <u>WORKS</u>

C6.5.1 Requirements for the sourcing and engagement of labour

6.5.1.1 Unskilled and semi-skilled labour required for the execution of all labour intensive works shall be engaged strictly in accordance with prevailing legislation and SANS 1914-5, Participation of Targeted Labour.

- 6.5.1.2 The rate of pay set for the SPWP is R160.00 per task or per day (Minimum).
- 6.5.1.3 Tasks established by the contractor must be such that:
 - a) the average worker completes 5 tasks per week in 40 hours or less; and
 - b) the weakest worker completes 5 tasks per week in 55 hours or less.



- 6.5.1.4 The contractor must revise the time taken to complete a task whenever it is established that the time taken to complete a weekly task is not within the requirements of 6.5.1.3.
- 6.5.1.5 The Contractor shall, through all available community structures, inform the local community of the labour intensive works and the employment opportunities presented thereby. Preference must be given to people with previous practical experience in construction and / or who come from households:
 - a) where the head of the household has less than a primary school education;
 - b) that have less than one full time person earning an income;
 - c) where subsistence agriculture is the source of income.
 - d) those who are not in receipt of any social security pension income
- 6.5.1.6 The Contractor shall endeavour to ensure that the expenditure on the employment of temporary workers is in the following proportions:
 - a) 40 % women;
 - b) 20% youth who are between the ages of 18 and 35; and
 - c) 2% on persons with disabilities.
- 6.5.1.7 The Contractor in Consultation with the Community representatives must recommend task rates to be used on the Project for approval by the O. R. Tambo District Municipality.

- 1. All prices quoted must include VAT, if the bidder is a registered VAT vendor.
- Prices quoted must include delivery costs and goods must be delivered to the address provided.
- 3. All prices submitted must be firm. Firm prices are deemed to be fixed prices, which are only subject to statutory changes.
